### Directions from M60 West

- Leave the M60 at junction 27 (marked Stockport East) straight on to a large roundabout.
- Take the fourth exit marked A626 to Marple.
- Continue up a hill to the second set of traffic lights and turn left along the A626 towards Marple.
- Continue along the A626 for about four miles, through Offerton and a woodland area, which is on the outskirts of Marple.

### Directions from M60 East

- Leave the M60 at junction 25 (marked Bredbury)
- Take the A560 towards Bredbury. Follow the A560 left at the second set of traffic lights.
- At the second set of traffic lights after turning left, turn right into the A6017 signposted towards Hazel Grove and Marple.
- After half a mile on the A6017, turn right at traffic lights into the A627, towards Marple and Hazel Grove.
- After about a mile, turn left at traffic lights onto the A626 towards Marple.

### As you enter Marple

- Turn right at the first set of traffic lights, by Somerfield petrol filling station on the right, and a signpost to All Saints' Church on the far traffic light in the centre of the junction.
- Continue up Church Lane up to a mini-roundabout.
- Go straight across the mini-roundabout, to the upper part of Church Lane and past All Saints' School.
- Continue up to the top of the hill, where you will find All Saints' Church on the left. Turn left into the car park

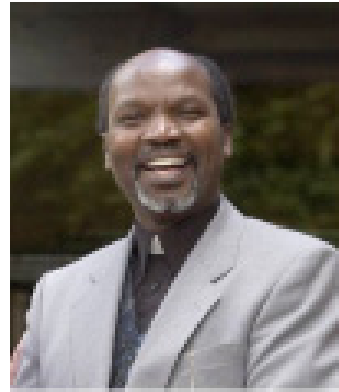
